## Student Housing Incident Update:

On Thursday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 5:00 pm, an incident was reported at NCCC Student Housing. The investigation revealed an NCCC student was assaulted by four unknown males in which a weapon may have been involved. The incident occurred in a hallway at the student housing village. The victim was treated for a head laceration at urgent care and released. It has been determined this is an isolated incident and does not pose a threat to the campus community. The college is working with investigators to identify the individuals involved.

The Niagara County Sheriff's office is investigating along with NCCC Public Safety. Anyone that may have any information on this incident should contact Investigator Gaydos at the Niagara County Sheriff's Department at 716-438-3407 or NCCC Public Safety at 716-614-6400.
