Walk-ins welcome during these hours and more hours will be coming soon! All major credit cards are accepted, no cash.

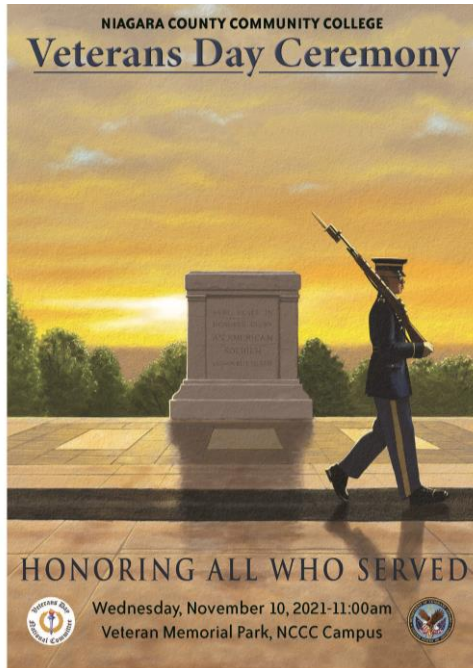
