## Fall 2021 Graduation Application Deadline:

The deadline to file for Fall graduation is THIS WEEK December 10<sup>th</sup>. If you plan to earn more than one degree and/or certificate in the Fall semester, please submit a graduation application for both.

- Apply through Banner Web:
  - Click on "Student Records"
  - o Click on "Apply for Graduation"
  - Select the major you are applying for. If you do not see your major listed, please contact the Enrollment Center at 716-614-6250.
  - o Verify how your name should appear on your diploma.
  - o Review the information you entered is correct and click "Submit Request"
  - o You can view your submitted application under the Student Records tab of Banner Web at any time.

Reminder: As we continue to slow the spread of COVID-19, please remember that all students and employees are required to wear a mask over their noses and mouths in public indoor settings, regardless of vaccination status. It has been brought to my attention that people on campus are negligent about the proper way to wear a mask, or they are not wearing a mask at all. #### The NCCC mask mandate specifies:

- Dining: Students and employees may remove their masks when seated and eating.
- Classrooms: Faculty and students are required to mask in indoor classrooms and labs.
- Meetings/Office Spaces: Masking is required in shared office spaces as well as in meetings. This includes all student meetings and events. Masks can be removed in private offices.
- Masks are not required outdoors.

The Public Safety officers on both campuses will continue to enforce the NCCC mask mandate.

Wearing face masks is just one step the College is taking to keep the NCCC community as safe as possible during the COVID pandemic. We need everyone to do their part to help with this effort.
