Dropping Courses:

The last day to DROP a Spring 2022 course without it appearing on your transcript/schedule is **Monday**, **February 7**. Students have the following options to drop a course on or before February 7:

- 1. Drop online in Banner Web: <u>Click here</u> for detailed instructions (*This option will no longer be available for Spring classes starting February 8*).
- 2. Complete the <u>Drop or Withdraw from a Course Request Form.</u>
- 3. Contact the Enrollment Center from your T-Wolves email at records@niagaracc.suny.edu. The email MUST come from your T-Wolves email account.

Starting Tuesday, February 8, students have the following options available to WITHDRAW from a class. If you choose to withdraw from a course after February 7, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned.

- 1. Complete the <u>Drop or Withdraw from a Course Request Form</u>.
- Email the Enrollment Center from your T-Wolves email at <u>records@niagaracc.suny.edu</u>. The email MUST come from your T-Wolves email account.
