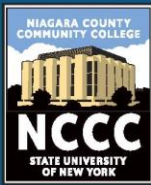

## Spring 2022 Graduation Application Deadline

**The deadline to file for Spring graduation is April 29th.** If you plan to earn more than one degree and/or certificate in the Fall semester, please submit a graduation application for both.

Apply through Banner Web:

Click on "Student Records"

Click on "Apply for Graduation"

Select the major you are applying for. If you do not see your major listed, please contact the Enrollment Center at 716-614-6250.

Verify how your name should appear on your diploma.

Review the information you entered is correct and click "Submit Request"

You can view your submitted application under the Student Records tab of Banner Web at any time.

Niagara County Community College and the Niagara Falls City School District.

**Dr. Bloneva Bond (1918-2004)** was the first Black woman elected to the Niagara Falls School Board and was a past president of the Niagara Falls Chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). Bond was appointed by then-governor, Nelson A. Rockefeller to both the State Health Council and the State Health Planning Commission.

## KEY DATES

APRIL 2022

- April 1st: Scholarship Deadline (Fall 2022 awards)** – To apply for the many NCCC scholarships available, visit the Scholarship webpage at [Niagara.ccsuny.edu/scholarships](http://Niagara.ccsuny.edu/scholarships).
- April 1st: Financial Aid On-Time Deadline** – All students should file a FAFSA by this date to secure funds for Fall classes. Don't delay! Applications filed after this date may not show up as processed on your bill.
- April 4th: Registration** – Fall Registration begins for READMIT (returning) students.
- April 11th: Registration** – Fall Registration begins for non-degree seeking (non-matriculated) students.
- April 11th: Registration** – Fall Registration begins for NEW & TRANSFER students.
- April 15th: Good Friday** – College Closed.
- April 18th: Deadline for Spring S/U or W grades (note: modular courses differ in deadlines)** – Decision Day! Should a course be dropped to get a "W" grade or is the course salvageable? See your instructor! Don't wait until the last day! Dropping a course may negatively affect progress toward your degree – talk with your advisor! Dropping a course may also affect your eligibility for Financial Aid – speak to someone in the Financial Aid Office.  
Contact the **Student Success Center** at 716-614-6290 or **Enrollment Center** at 716-614-6250
- Last day to Withdraw from all Spring classes, X grades on transcript (note: modular courses differ in deadlines)** – Withdrawing from all classes results in "X" grades and may affect your Financial Aid and academic standing. Contact your **Student Success Center Academic Coach** at 716-614-6290 or **Enrollment Center** at 716-614-6250. You may withdraw from the college online through the Withdrawal from College form.
- April 30th: Graduation Application Deadline** – Log into Banner Web. Under "Student Records" select "Apply for Graduation." You cannot graduate without completing this application! If you are earning a degree and a certificate or more than one degree, be sure to apply for **BOTH**

# Apply for the Waller Multicultural Scholarship today

**\$5,000 | Renewable | Stackable**

The Waller Scholarship is a renewable and competitive \$5,000 award for graduating Niagara County Community College multicultural students interested in continuing their education at Niagara University.

The Waller Scholarship will offer four talented multicultural graduates from NCCC the financial resources they may need to earn a bachelor's degree at NU. The \$5,000 scholarship can be combined with Niagara's merit-based award incentives (between \$13,000 to \$20,000 per year) and other financial aid opportunities to make a university education accessible and affordable to all.



With Niagara University's commitment to a Vincentian-based educational value system, each Waller Scholarship recipient will have access to academic programs and resources that will pave a better career path for themselves while becoming compassionate, productive members of the community.

## Scholarship Requirements

- Submission of official transcripts
- Proof of graduation from Niagara County Community College
- Completion of scholarship essay highlighting community involvement and community service
- Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, administrator, or community leader
- Application to Niagara University

Scholarship applications are due April 15, and will be awarded during the first week of May.



\* Multicultural refers to individuals that identify and fall into the following groups: Underrepresented racial and ethnic marginalized identities (Black / African American, Native Hawaiian / Asian Pacific Islander, American Indian / Alaskan Native, Latinx / Hispanic)

Student-athletes and international students are not eligible for this scholarship
