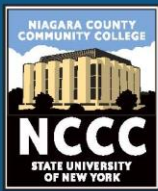

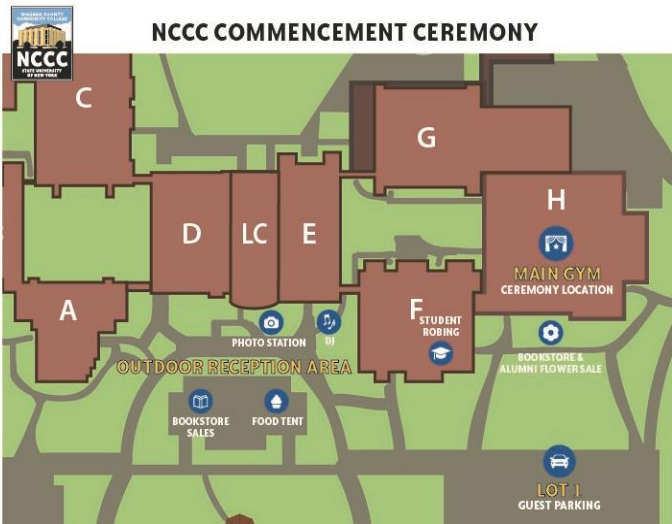
Congratulations to upcoming graduates!

As a reminder, the NCCCC Commencement Ceremony will be held on Saturday, May 14 at 10:00 a.m. in the Main Gym on the Sanborn Campus. On the day of the ceremony, graduates are asked to arrive at 9:00 a.m. and report to the Arts and Media Theatre in F. Building. **Please note that caps & gowns must be purchased at the Barnes and Noble bookstore in Sanborn or at NFCl by Wednesday, May 4 in order to participate.** Two tickets will be provided to each graduate registered for the ceremony. Ticket pick-up is from Thursday, May 5 – Friday, May 13 in the Barnes and Noble location where you purchased your cap & gown. Tickets not picked up by Friday, May 13 will be forfeited. The availability of extra tickets will be determined after cap and gown sales close on Wednesday, May 4. An email will be sent on Thursday, May 5 to alert graduates if their extra ticket request can be fulfilled. The commencement ceremony will also be streamed live in the Learning Commons and on the NCCCC website for anyone not able to attend the event in the Main Gym. -  **May 23rd: Summer Full Term (12 wk) & Summer Session I (6 wk) classes begin** - Excellent opportunity to make up classes or to reduce course load for future semesters.

Add/Drop period for Summer Full Term (12 wk) & Session I (6 wk) - Students can add or drop classes on their schedule anytime online in Banner Web until 9:59 PM on May 23rd (*financial liability may apply*). Advisement assistance available through the Student Success Center (D102) for students who want to speak with an advisor before changing their schedule.

Non-Matriculated registration ends for Summer Session I (6 wk) & Full Term (12 wk).
-  **May 30th: Memorial Day** - College Closed.
