



## Who's Ready for Fall 2022 at NCCC??

### Fall 2022 COVID Protocol:

As Niagara County Community College continues to navigate the pandemic and in order to continue to protect all students, faculty, and staff, we must be diligent in ensuring the health and safety of our campus community. As the virus continues to evolve, we must adapt to the ever-changing guidance and flexibility. The following guidance is in effect for fall 2022, however, protocols are subject to change as COVID continues to develop. We will monitor and communicate as needed.

#### Vaccination/Booster Requirement

The SUNY Student COVID-19 Vaccine Policy (the "Policy") remains in effect and requires all students who will have a physical presence on campus to provide evidence of, at minimum, the initial course of COVID vaccinations. Pursuant to the Policy, students are considered fully vaccinated for the initial course of vaccination: (1) two weeks after receiving the second dose in a two dose COVID-19 vaccine series or (2) two weeks after receiving a single dose COVID-19 vaccine. Students will be required to submit documentation of their vaccination status by September 2, 2022 to remain in their face-to-face courses, in their on-campus housing, and on their athletic rosters.

All students are strongly encouraged to stay up-to-date on their vaccinations as defined by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), including obtaining any booster authorized by the FDA and recommended by the CDC for their age group. While not required at this time, SUNY reserves the authority to impose a requirement for any booster at any time as a result of changes in local conditions or as a result of requirements imposed by Federal, State or local authorities. Students enrolled in any program or course or who are participating in a clinical or internship held at a third-party location must continue to comply with all health and safety guidelines, including any vaccination or testing protocols that are in place at the third-party location.

The Wellness Center will monitor student vaccination throughout the semester and send reminder notifications to students about their requirements. If you do not complete your process within 30-days of the semester start (September 30, 2022), campus access may be denied (including withdrawal of face-to-face courses) until you become compliant.

#### Testing Requirements

Students who received a medical or religious exemption will be required to test weekly. Students may either test off-campus (home tests will not be permitted) and submit verification to the Assistant Vice President of Student Services and Campus Engagement [McKeown@niagaracc.suny.edu](mailto:McKeown@niagaracc.suny.edu) or may pool test on-campus on the Sanborn or NFCI campus. Dates and times will be posted on the NCCC website. Students who do not test as required may be suspended from campus access until they have completed the required testing.

#### Masking Requirements

Masks are no longer required to be worn by vaccinated or unvaccinated students or employees while on campus. However, all are encouraged to wear masks and observe social distancing indoors, as well in instructional space (e.g., classrooms, laboratories, offices) to help mitigate the spread of the virus. Students may also be advised to wear masks by the Wellness Center if they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive.

#### Medical/Religious Exemptions

Niagara County Community College will review medical and religious exemption requests for students who complete the required paperwork. Information can be found at this site - <https://www.niagaracc.suny.edu/wellness/>. Exemption request should be submitted to the Wellness Center prior the start of the semester for review. The absolute deadline for exemption request is September 30, 2022 for the fall semester. No requests will be reviewed for the fall 2022 semester after this deadline.
