Apply through Banner Web:

- Click on "Student Records"
- Click on "Apply for Graduation"
- Select the major you are applying for. If you do not see your major listed, please contact the Enrollment Center at 716-614-6250.
- Verify how your name should appear on your diploma.
- Review the information you entered is correct and click "Submit Request"
- You can view your submitted application under the Student Records tab of Banner Web at any time.

August 3rd: Summer (full) S/U/W/X Deadline – Last day to elect S/U/W/X for Summer Full Term (12 wk).

August 9th: Transfer Tuesday – Online information session for incoming students transferring to NCCC from another college or university with admissions and transfer credit questions. Visit <https://www.niagaracc.suny.edu/transfer/> for more information and to RSVP!

August 11th: Summer II S/U/W/X Deadline – Last day to elect S/U/W/X for Summer Session II (6 wk).

August 12th: Graduation Application Deadline – Deadline to submit graduation application for Summer graduates.

August 17th: Barnes & Nobles Purchases Using Financial Aid – First day students can use financial aid to purchase books/supplies online and in person through Barnes & Nobles Bookstore (Sanborn) or Barnes & Noble College Bookstore (NFCI) for Fall 2022 semester.

August 18th: Instruction ends for Summer – Instruction ends for Summer Session II (6 wk) and Summer Full Term (12 wk) classes.

August 22nd: Final Grades Posted – Summer II & Full Term Final Grades posted on Banner Web after 4 pm.

August 28th: Fall Drop Deadline (Banner Web) – Last day to drop Fall class(es) on Banner Web only with 100% refund (offices closed; modular courses differ in deadlines – see Modular Class Dates tab at <https://www.niagaracc.suny.edu/registration-records/studentcalendar/>).

August 29th: Fall Classes Begin – Be sure to check your schedule in Banner Web to make sure room locations or modalities have not changed.

August 29th-31st: Fall Add/Drop Period – Students can add or drop classes on their schedule anytime online in Banner Web until 9:59 PM on September 1st (*financial liability may apply*). **Advisement assistance available** through the **Student Success Center (D-102)** for students who want to speak with an advisor before changing their schedule.
