#### **Current students**

- Current students can schedule Winter and/or Spring 2023 classes beginning Monday, October 17.
- Determine the first day YOU can register for classes in Banner Web by checking your <u>registration eligibility date</u> at the top of your degree evaluation in <u>Degree Works</u> and be sure to <u>schedule an appointment to meet with your Academic Advisor</u> to create your plan for next semester. ## **Alliance Federal Credit Union News:**




