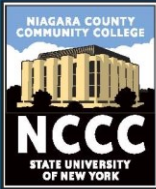

Drop/Delete Deadline for Spring 2023 Courses:

The deadline to drop/delete Spring 2023 full-term courses is **Monday, February 6**. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that financial liabilities may occur. Click [here](#) for more details.

Get in-person tax help and **FILE FOR FREE!**

Tax Department employees will walk you through your income tax returns, step-by-step, as you complete your own tax return. **It's quick and easy!** We'll help you prepare and e-file your income tax return in person at a location near you.

In partnership with **Niagara County Community College Library**, sessions will be offered on Wednesdays at Sanborn campus (2/1, 2/15, 3/1, 3/29, and 4/12) and at Niagara Falls Culinary Institute (2/8, 2/22, 3/8, 3/22, and 4/5).

- If you earned \$73,000 or less in 2022, you qualify.
- Use on-site computers, or your own laptop, tablet, or mobile device.
- You only need basic computer skills and an active email account.
- Safe and secure online tax software.
- Bring your 2022 tax documents and a copy of your 2021 tax returns (if you filed).

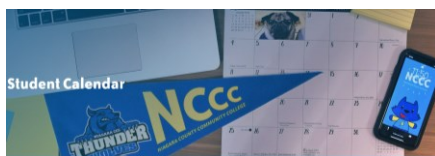
