Need to Order an Official Transcript? Place your order online through Banner Web:

- Click on the Student Records tab
- Click on Academic Transcript Order Official or
- Go to the Registration & Records webpage and click on the "Order Official Transcripts" button.
- There is a \$10 fee for each official transcript ordered.

Please note: Unofficial transcripts are free of charge and may be obtained by logging into Banner Web; click on the Student Records tab; choose Academic Transcripts – View Unofficial.

Drop/Delete Deadline for Spring 2023 Courses:

The deadline to drop/delete Spring 2023 full-term courses is TODAY--February 6. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that financial liabilities may occur. Click here for more details. To drop a class:

Use Myhub for free enrollment verifications!

Myhub is a free and secure online application provided by the National Student Clearinghouse. Myhub provides you with access to your verified education record from Niagara County Community College and all other colleges and universities that participate in Myhub where you also have an academic record.

Myhub offers many convenient self-service features, such as:

- · Download and print enrollment, advanced registration, and "good student discount" certificates
- Order transcripts
- · Add digital credentials hosted on Credly to your Myhub learner record

Through Myhub, you have lifetime access to your complete academic record of enrollment and degrees earned from participating institutions. You'll also benefit from immediate access to new capabilities and resources, which will serve you throughout your professional life, as they are added to Myhub. 

Tutoring Availability Schedule

Please Read Before Making An Appointment: Please pay close attention to the "Location" column as this will tell you if the tutoring service is available in-person (in ACE) or online. When you sign up for the appointment, you may be asked if you prefer in-person or online, but make sure the tutor will be available for your chosen modality! Some of our tutors are available in-person one day, but only online the next. Our tutoring policy states that students may schedule an appointment with a tutor for one hour (2 30-minute sessions) per day, per content area. If the tutor does not have a scheduled appointment after this time, the student may continue to work with the tutor. All students are expected to use their NCCC (T-Wolves) email when making an appointment. We will only send ZOOM video conference links to T-Wolves emails.

Appointment Cancellations: If you cannot attend a tutoring appointment, you are responsible for cancelling the appointment before the scheduled start time. If you do not cancel your appointment (no call/no show), you will receive a warning email from ACE. Consecutively missed appointments can result in appointment-making privileges being pulled. You can cancel an appointment one of the following ways:
