  - Review the information you entered is correct and click "Submit Request"

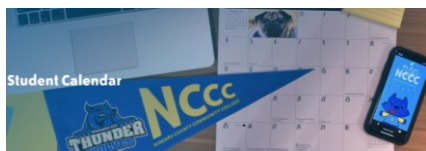
