The Wellness Center has contracted with TELUS Health (formerly LifeWorks) to provide Tele Counseling services for our students after hours, weekends, holidays, etc. They are actually available 24/7. This service is called My SSP. My SSP connects students with free, confidential professional counseling available 24/7 via app, telephone and web. Confidential, real-time virtual counseling available 24/7 via chat and phone. Students may talk with a professional counselor at their convenience through live chat or a simple phone call. 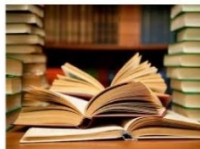
December 23rd to 31st Winter Recess - College Closed No Shuttle Service

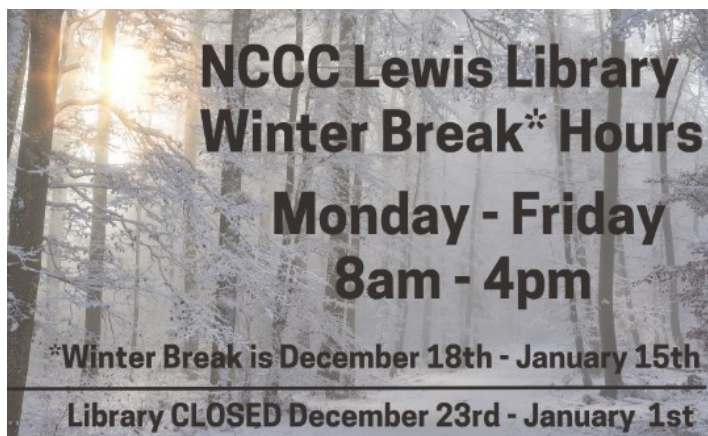
[Graphic Novels](#) – recent and classic graphic novels. The display is on the main (2nd) floor of the library near the reference desk.
