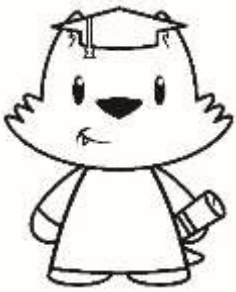

KEYNOTE SPEAKER - CHAD RIDGELY
Having worked as a writer and actor, Chad Ridgely studied in the Screenwriting Thesis MFA program where he received the degree of MFA from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He is best known by movie fans for writing, directing, and producing the award-winning comedy film *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying* on Kable 25 and *Mad Men*. Ridgely directed in the 2018 short comedy series, *The Chad Ridgely Show* and his appearance in several film and TV projects including *Quinn*. Director's short series *From a Midwestern and Looking* and *Transgressive*. *Wish Upon*.

SPECIAL GUEST - RICK CATZONE
Riposte and special effects artist has over 30 years experience in the industry. During this experience, he has worked on projects: *Chaplin*, *2 Bad 2 Beautiful*, *Stanger with a Camera*, and the original rights of *The Long Road*. Directed by George Butler, he also got the animation for *Take My 2 Pounds*. *Green a Green* video, which won a lifetime award for Best Long Form Music Video and he got his effects work on the way to such films as *Dark Night*, *2nd Death*, *Manhattan*, and *Chaplin*.

Join film director Chad Ridgely as he provides a personal screening of his award-winning horror thriller "Self Isolated" (2021). After the screening there will be time for audience Q&A and meeting the director.

"Self Isolated" is a slow burn horror thriller about a woman that wakes up one morning and finds herself seemingly alone in the world. Where is everyone? Where is her husband? And what has happened to the world around her? Through a series of flashback memories, the woman starts to piece together what's really going on. And while all of that is happening, the woman also has to deal with a potentially dangerous outside force. It's a fascinating movie because you're never quite sure if you should trust the woman's memories or what seems to be happening to her in the "real" world.
